The purpose of this exhibition is to provide Aboriginal Youth with an opportunity to gain recognition and exposure they deserve. It will help other Newfoundlanders and Labradorians understand and appreciate the distinct contribution made by Aboriginal peoples to the province's culture and heritage. It will also provide an educational tool for the general public.

All artists are invited to submit:

-A biography

-At least five (5) photographs, or a CD- ROM containing at least five (5) images (at least 4 x 5 inches and 300 dots per inch,) or fifteen (15) different 35mm slides of their work.

-Each photo, digital image, or slide should be labeled with the artist name, title of work, date, media used, and dimensions.

-Must be submitted on or before MAY 31, 2006.

Works that are not identified will not be reviewed. If you feel your work should be seen but you do not meet requirements or you lack the materials, please contact us anyway. We are here to help.
